A day long workshop on Automation of National Savings Certificates (NSC) Online Management System held at Finance division on 06 august 2025, was organized by the scheme on Strengthening the Capacity of the Treasury and Debt Management Wing of the Finance Division under the Strengthening Public Financial Management Program to Enable Service Delivery (SPFMS).

The program was presided over by Mr Hasan Khaled Foisal, Additional Secretary (TDM) of the Finance Division. Mr Md Firoz Khan, Program Executive and Coordinator (PEC) made welcome speech. Mr Md. The system enables clients to receive profits and principal directly their bank accounts through EFT. NID-based verification, TIN checks and OTP confirmations enhance security and accuracy. These reforms have reduced client time, cost and visits while eliminating manual reimbursement complications. With strong technical infrastructure and expanded support systems, the NSS online Management System sets a new benchmark in fiscal governance and public service delivery.

This initiative strengthens public trust, promotes financial inclusion and brings long-term savings management into digital era.
